


Acceptance conditions plastic

Incoming material is subjected to a visual inspection during unloading at our location in Esbeek. The inspection shows whether the goods meet the quality requirements per type of material or the specific agreements made about a batch.


Documentation

Delivered freight must also be accompanied by the legally required freight documents (and quality) according to the guidelines of EVOA (at least a CMR or guidance form and, if necessary with a transport from the outside of the Netherlands, a correctly completed Annex VII). It is the responsibility of the disposer to indicate the correct Eural code if known (Eural code 20.01.39 stands for plastics, but it should be more specific where possible). If the paperwork is correct and the material is approved by our inspector, a cargo will be accepted.

Accepted material:

-  Soft (transparent) packaging film, LDPE bags, LDPE shrink sleeves, LDPE tube sleeve, LLDPE stretch foe, HDPE bags and covers, agricultural and horticultural foe (black/natural) and LLDPE agri-stretch film (green), PET thermoforming or vacuum foe, PP (gloss) foe and PP/PS flower pots and trays. All with less than 2% of adhering organic and/ or inorganic substances. llllllll

A cargo must not be contaminated:

-  Adhesive tape or sticker residues, products with powder/ spray-sensitive residues, Styrofoam, wood, tin, caulking syringes, glass, metal, paper, ink cartridges, and other waste below.

The disposer undertakes to inform Broeckx Plastic Recycng BV whether the delivered cargo contains substances and/or materials that fall outside the acceptance conditions.li

Not suitable for recycling:

The following substances are not suitable for recycling and are therefore refused. A cargo must always be free of and must not have served as packaging for substances that:

- toxic and/or otherwise hazardous (no paint residues or other chemical waste)
- cause a nuisance odour and/or dust (no carcasses or parts thereof, faeces, meat, fish and offal);li
- may cause damage to human, animal and crop health;
- are susceptible to spontaneous combustion and are highly flammable or explosive;
- develop explosive, flammable, toxic, harmful and/or disgusting gases in contact with water;
- may cause damage to soil, surface and/or groundwater;
- are environmentally difficult, aesthetically and/or technically difficult to process;
- are radioactive, release ionising rays or contain emitting substances;
- be presented in closed drums, bottles, canisters, boxes and containers, provided that their contents cannot be directly controlled;

- contain bituminous substances and petroleum products (or substances thereof);
- are specific hospital waste.

Finally. Every cargo offered must be free of glowing, smoldering and/or burning objects.

Entry control:

Upon arrival, the material is visually checked by our employees. This is done, if possible, before unloading the material. If not possible, this is checked after unloading the material.

Rejected material:

If material is refused after entry control, this material remains the property of the sending party. All consequences and costs arising from this refused party are for the sending party.

Broeckx Plastic Recycling BV will inform the sending party by telephone or e-mail of the detected deviation (provided with photos where necessary) and, where possible, provide advice to prevent such contamination in the future. The material is set aside and preferably returned to the sending party. Unless otherwise agreed in writing with the sending party, the material will not be processed or deposited. If the sending party does not respond to communication from Broeckx Plastic Recycling BV regarding the refused party, Broeckx Plastic Recycling BV is entitled to have the refused material disposed of in an environmentally responsible manner and to charge all resulting costs (including cleaning costs) to the sending party.

Broeckx Plastic Recycling BV will report all material that is refused after entry control in the management system. This makes it possible to periodically assess the operation of these acceptance conditions and the delivery reliability of customers and suppliers. If necessary, Broeckx Plastic Recycling BV reserves the right to contact the customer / supplier to increase the delivery reliability of the material or to terminate the delivery relationship.
